

# Checklist for enrolling in Catamount Health with Premium Assistance

(and Medicaid, VHAP, and Dr. Dynasaur)

\_\_\_\_\_ Fill out, sign and mail “Application for Health Care Programs and WIC”  
date mailed

\_\_\_\_\_ Show proof of citizenship\*\* (see below for examples) if the state asks you to do this  
date completed

\_\_\_\_\_ Receive determination of eligibility for one of the public health programs  
date received

\_\_\_\_\_ Receive notification of monthly premium (if any). Pay premium as soon as possible.  
date paid

\_\_\_\_\_ If you are enrolling in Catamount Health, you will receive information from the State  
date mailed about both Blue Cross Blue Shield and MVP's version of Catamount Health. Contact  
Green Mountain Care Member Services at 1 800 250 8427 with your decision about  
which carrier's version of Catamount Health you will be choosing.

\_\_\_\_\_ You should receive your Health Care ID cards and information about Catamount Health  
date received from your chosen provider.

Please note that this list covers the most common steps, but may not be all-inclusive. Other steps may be required. If you have access to employer sponsored insurance, the state may require you to provide additional information **It is important to keep copies of all paperwork you send to the State (if possible) and copies of all notices mailed to you by the State.** If you wish to find out the status of your application, call the State at 1-800-250-8427. If you receive confusing or conflicting information, or think you have been wrongly denied coverage, please call 1.866.482.4723 for assistance or go to:

\*\* in order to get health care assistance you need to prove both ID and U.S. citizenship:

1. Both can be proved with a current or expired passport.
2. A combination of proving citizenship through an original birth certificate and ID through a driver's license.
3. A combination of proving citizenship through resident alien status and ID through a driver's license.
4. The final option, if a person has no birth certificate, is for them to get two signed statements proving citizenship and prove ID through a driver's license (please call 1-866-482-4723 if you need help with this process).
